

# *Turtleneck Poncho*



**Material :8 Balls/ 50g Schoeller & Stahl Wonderwool color of your choice**  
**US # 15 circular needle 26 Inch , US # 15 circular needle 16 Inch**  
**Crochet Hook**  
**Tapestry Needle**  
**Stitch marker**

**Gauge: 3 Stitches = 1 Inch**

Cast on 50 sts.

Pattern Repeat:

Row 1, 3, 5 K1, (K3, P3) repeat 7 times, K1

Row 2, 4, 6 K1, (K3, P3) repeat 7 times, K1

Row 7, 9, 11 K1, (P3, K3) repeat 7 times, K1

Row 8,10, 12 K1, (P3, K3) repeat 7 times, K1

Work row 1 – 12 until piece meas. 30”

Bind off all stitches.

Work 2nd rectangle same as 1<sup>st</sup>

Seam each short side to a long side.

Pick up 50-60 Stitches around the Neck, make sure you have an even number of stitches, place marker at the beg. of first Row and work 7 Rows in 1×1 Ribbing . Bind off .

For the Fringe cut Yarn in 11 Inch long strings and use Crochet Hook to attach bundles\* to the Bottom of the Poncho.  
( For each Fringe bundle you will need 3 strings.)
